Eligibility and Musical Requirements for 2022- 2023 Dora Dawson Music Awards Open to all Musicians, Senior High School and University Students

ELIGIBILITY:

Each award applicant must be a U.S. citizen, a resident of Oakland County Michigan, and no older than twenty-four years of age. Only the first eight applications which have been received on time will be accepted.

The application must include three signatures: 1. Applicant. 2. Parent (guardian). 3. Private instructor of the applicant. A photocopy of the applicant's birth certificate must accompany the application. It will be returned.

A current university applicant must already be enrolled as a music major or minor. A high school senior whose college application to study music is already in process may also apply.

PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE AUDITION:

Two solo works are required, one from the Baroque or Classical eras and one from Romantic or Modern eras. Memorization of one of the compositions is required. Most winners memorize two works, and judges will award extra points if both solo compositions are memorized. Each audition will be twenty (20) minutes in duration. If the music requires an accompanist, the applicant must furnish one.

ADJUDICATORS:

Qualified, impartial adjudicators will be provided, and their comments will be sent to the applicant. The applicant must bring original music scores for the audition, with all measures numbered. Following the applicant's musical performance, there will be a brief oral theory examination which may include the playing or singing of scales. Also, the student will be asked to demonstrate knowledge of music theory and sight-reading ability.

AWARDS: The Dora Dawson Award ranges between \$250. and \$1000. The amount of award monies will depend upon musical excellence, need, and the number of outstanding auditions. Musical excellence is rewarded. Each award winner will perform in a concert March 12, 2023 and receive the cash award at this time. (Each winner must provide income tax information.) Award winners may not re-audition the next year for the same award, but they may audition for the Rosamond Haeberle Piano Award.

Auditions will be held, beginning at 9:00 AM on January 7, 2023
